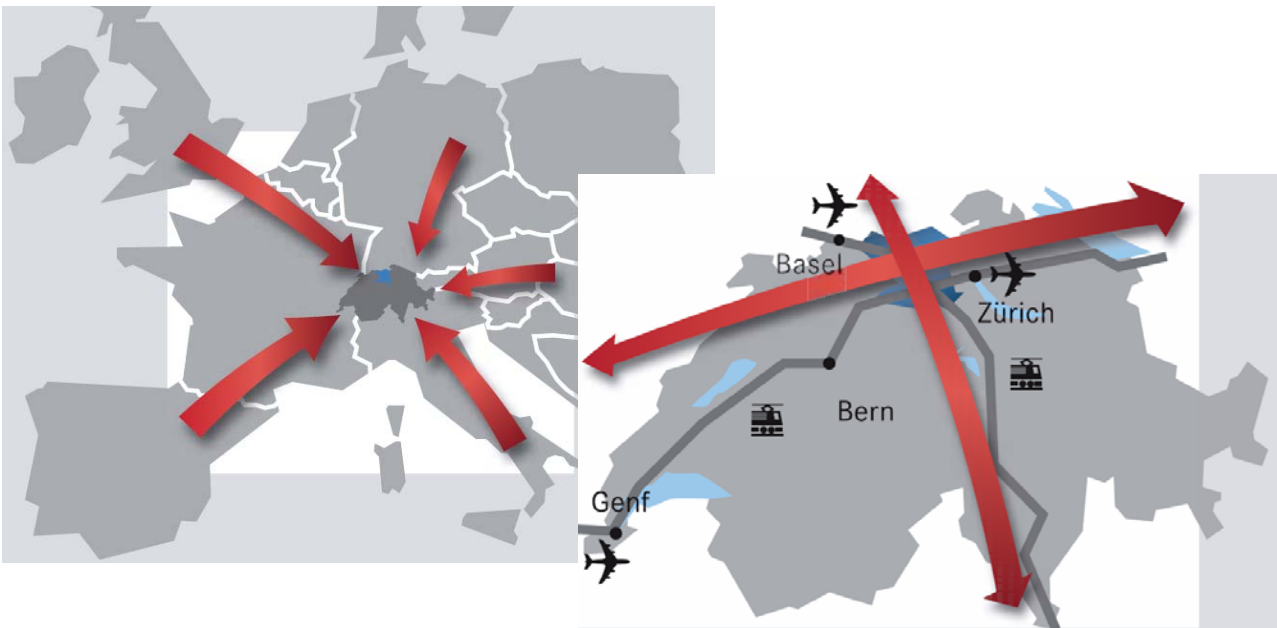




Central Location in Europe

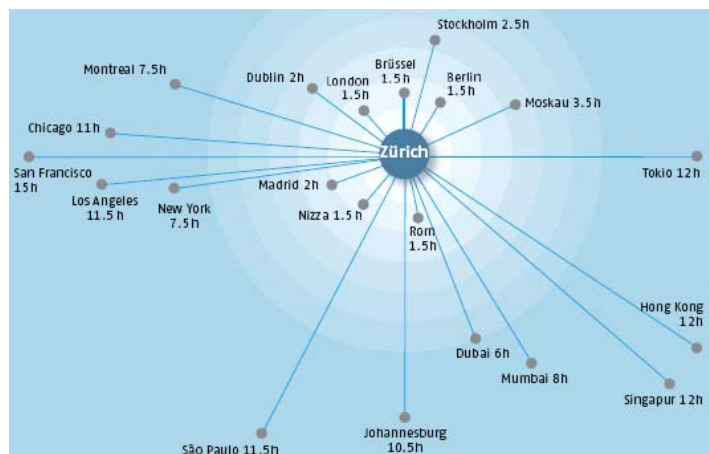
Right in the middle of Europe, Canton Aargau is optimally-connected to nearby foreign countries. Canton Aargau lies at the crossroads of major traffic routes between the Swiss economic centers of Berne, Basle and Zurich, and borders on Germany. The most important transit routes pass through Aargau.

Economic centers in nearby France and Germany are quickly and easily reached by car, train or airplane.



Thanks to 3 international airports that are quickly reachable from Aargau, most large European airlines are only a stone's throw away.

Airport Zurich offers direct flights to 150 cities in 80 different countries. The most important European cities can be reached within a maximum of 2 hours.

In addition to excellent connections via the international aviation network, rail transit in the European network is well-integrated. Munich, for example, can be reached comfortably within 5 hours, and Stuttgart within 3 ½ hours.

Public transportation, optimally-developed with an outstanding rail network, allows rapid connection by train to important cities in Switzerland.
