**COVID-19 vaccination**

**1. Registering for your COVID-19 vaccination**

Before you register, please read the following explanations in full.

People under the age of 65 with pre-existing conditions at the highest level of risk need a doctor's certificate to receive the vaccination.

From 7 May, everyone over the age of 16 within the Canton of Aargau will receive a vaccination appointment, with appointments being issued on a first-come, first-serve basis. The following groups will remain a priority:

- People over the age of 65
- People with pre-existing conditions at the highest level of risk (must provide a doctor's certificate)
- Healthcare personnel and socio-medical personnel (must provide confirmation from their employer)

Any other groups that were previously prioritised will no longer receive priority vaccination appointments. This includes people with pre-existing conditions that are not at the highest level of risk or relatives of particularly at-risk individuals.

If you live outside the Canton of Aargau, you cannot be vaccinated in the Canton of Aargau. Healthcare personnel and socio-medical personnel working in the Canton of Aargau are an exception to this.

Register here for a vaccination appointment, regardless of your age or any pre-existing conditions. As soon as a vaccination appointment is available for you, you'll receive an SMS with your appointment. If you cannot make this appointment, you can reject your appointment and register for a new one. At the moment, you cannot choose when you will be vaccinated.

You cannot choose the vaccine with which you are vaccinated.
